Neuware - The Cheonjeon-ri Petroglyphs in Various Angles : Nine experts specializing in rock art contributed articles to the book The Cheonjeon-ri Petroglyphs in Ulsan are unique as prehistoric petroglyphs, historic period fine-line engravings, and inscribed texts are displayed on the same panel. The Bangudae Petroglyphs Institute of University of Ulsan has been publishing its annual English publication series, World Petroglyphs Research, and this year's issue is on the Cheonjeon-ri Petroglyphs. Nine authors, including archaeologists, art historians, and historians from Europe, the US, and Korea, contributed chapters to the book.
